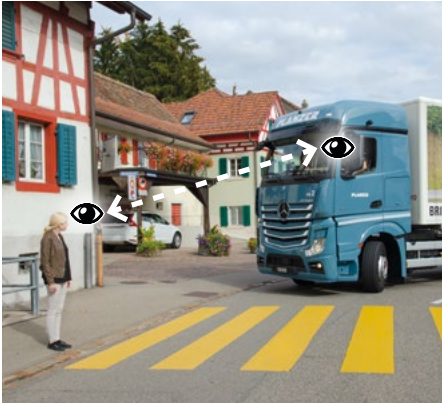


THE RIGHT BEHAVIOUR

When someone is in a blind spot, they are invisible to the driver.

First make eye contact with the driver, then cross the street.



As a precaution when cycling, do not try to pass lorries.

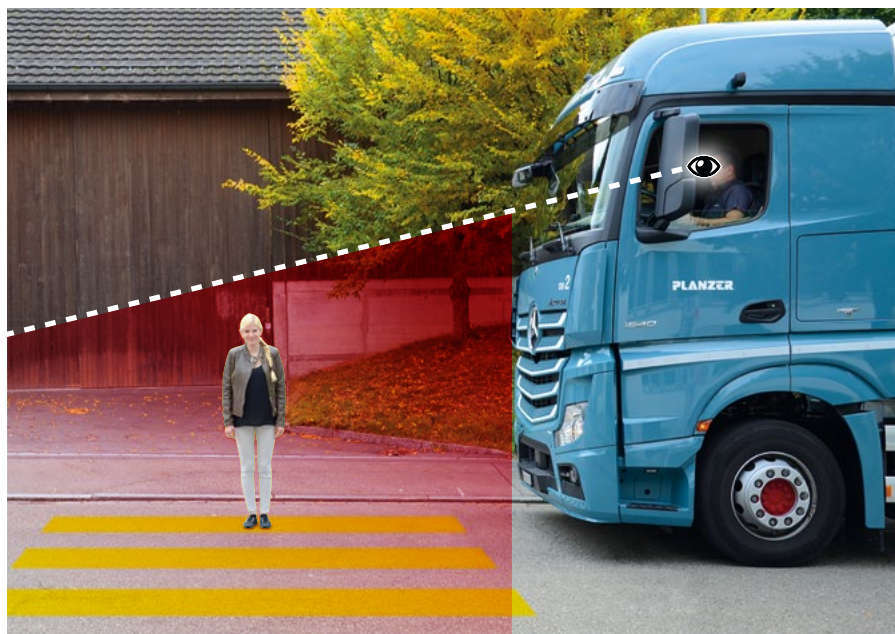

RECOGNISING BLIND SPOTS

Everything that is located in a blind spot ...



... is invisible to the person driving the vehicle.



AVOIDING BLIND SPOTS

Someone is standing in a blind spot.



However, the driver can't see anyone in the side mirror.



BASIC RULES

- Always seek **eye contact** with the **person driving the vehicle**.
- Keep a wide **distance** between **you and the side of a vehicle**.
